All our walkers need to do, are the distances they normally do, except over a 1km course, not a 2km course. By doing this they will receive their Fastest and Handicap points in their own divisions. Good luck and fast times please!

There are also 2 perpetual trophies today. These are the Hadley Cup to be presented to the combined handicap winner of the 10km for the Long and Medium division men and the McDougall trophy to the combined handicap winner of the 10km for the Long and Medium division women.
